Girls Only:	Girls, 9th-12th Grade



Here's a check-off list of things you need to do before you start your club:

1. Get your Pastor's permission first before you go ahead and start a Club.
2. Don't rush!! Take your time to get all the information you need, Volunteers, training and more. The more prepared you are, the more successful your Clubs will be! This process can take from 2-4 months from planning to launching your first club.
1. FYI!! Let the District Director know you are going to start. She will be able to help you with the most current Girls Ministry resources, any new changes, and loads more. [www.whatevergirls.org](http://www.whatevergirls.org) -> Contact
2. Training Guide. Purchase Leader Training Guide, #02.MG1295—\$16.50 @ [www.gph.org](http://www.gph.org) -> go to Girls Ministries section. This book will give you the foundation on our Clubs, what they require, overviews of each Club and more. GPH's #1.800.641.4310
3. Lights, Camera, Action! Put a plan of action together—What Clubs do you want to start off with? What are the needs of your church in this area? When do you want to start your Clubs? Wed/Sunday or another night?
4. Volunteers—Start looking for Volunteers. Host an information night for those that might possibly take an interest in teaching. 5. Team—Once you have your volunteer team together, host a meeting w/your new Leaders— this is a good night to hand out their Club Binders with all their teaching materials provided. Also note that all Sponsors/ Leaders Guides are now available on CD-Rom as well as binders. Should questions arise that you do not feel capable of answering, write them down and either send them to us via email or save for your Training date. If you like one of the Regional Leaders to assist you on your training night, just let us know. We would be thrilled to help!
6. Set a Launch Date.
7. Curriculum. Purchase your curriculum (see start-up curriculum guide)
8. Training. Set up a training with your Regional Leader or Girls Ministry Director. This is for you and all your volunteers.
9. Register your Club. When you launch your new club, go to [www.whatevergirls.org](http://www.whatevergirls.org) and register your club online. It's that simple. Fill out the online form and click send. This will let us know you have a Club, we will put you on our map of "Find a Club nearest you!", as well as keep you informed of all the latest Club news, Retreats, Celebration and more. Don't forget to give us your email. That is the BEST way we can stay in touch with you!!

*Registration is free to all our A/G Churches. If you are a non-A/G church, there is a yearly \$3.00/per club fee. You can still fill out the online registration form and send in your payment to the address provided below.*
